2008-09 UIL Dates for Eligibility

University Interscholastic League Guidelines set a 7-day grace period following the end of each reporting period established by a district calendar. In accordance with these guidelines, the following chart identifies the dates on which a student may either lose or regain eligibility at 3:30 PM at the conclusion of the 7-day grace period. This grace period is provided so that a student has an opportunity to complete work missed due to an absence within the last week of the reporting period. It is not a period for doing extra work to raise an average to passing.

- Students **will not lose eligibility** at the 3 week progress report period. At the time of a 3 weeks progress report, a student can only regain eligibility lost at the time of the previous six weeks report card.
- To regain eligibility, the student must be passing all courses, not just the course previously failed.
- A student **does not lose eligibility based on the semester average, but rather on the six weeks average.**
- All students are eligible during a school holiday of a full calendar week or more. (Christmas Break & Spring Break)
