The **dress for this concert** is choir shirt, jeans, and closed toed shoes. Make sure you have all of these items prepped and ready to go PRIOR to the day of the concert. Make sure that you have a choir shirt in your possession, and if you need to acquire one, please remember that the cost is \$10 per shirt.

The concert will begin at **7:30 p.m., October 8th, 2012**, and you need to be seated or in your respective place no later than 7:15. Please be signed in, and ready to begin at this time. Please remember that the sign-in sheets will be located on the stage right side of the auditorium stage. **DO NOT FORGET TO SIGN IN!!!!!!**

This concert will be held in the Brazoswood Auditorium. You will need to pick up your folder from the choir room, and then proceed to the auditorium to sign in, and take your seats.

Please remember that once you are seated, be kind and respectful of the group that is performing. You will be next onstage, and you want "them" to be respectful of "your" performance.

It is appropriate to CLAP between numbers, but it is NOT appropriate to catcall, yell, talk, or TEXT during a performance. All cell phones should be turned off.

You ARE expected to be in attendance for the entire concert, as the entire organization will be performing the closing number.

You are encouraged to support your fellow students that are performing by applauding their work and effort.

However, please remember that this is a public performance, and all eyes are on YOU!

REMEMBER:

Students missing a Brazoswood Choir Concert MUST complete the appropriate make-up assignment.

For this concert, you will only have until Thursday, October 11th, 2012 at 4:00 p.m. to BOTH bring a signed parent note, AND schedule a time with a director for the make-up session. Failure to complete these steps will result in a loss of credit for the entire event.
